



PLACEMENT

The placement Committee is a duly constituted committee of the Staff Council with a vision to impart necessary career guidance, training and skill-sets to students so that they are able to find the right job. We have successfully placed a large number of graduates who have appeared for placements. The Committee also acts as a link between the Placement Cell of the college and the college students for placement related activities.

Every year we organize *career counseling & orientation sessions* wherein students who are interested in placements//career guidance are encouraged to write industry-relevant curriculum vitae, participate in Group Discussions (GD) and Personal Interviews (PI).

Various companies have been visiting our campus for recruitment including etc. and selecting students after a rigorous Psychometric Test, Voice Test, and Personal Interview. There are an increasing number of students each year which are successfully getting placed through the coordinated efforts of the Placement Committee – last year (2015-16) more than 100 students were shortlisted.

It plays a very important and key role in counselling and guiding the students of the college for their successful career placement.
