JOINT DECLARATION BY THE STUDENT AND PARENT

If they come across any problem, they can bring it to the notice of concerned Head of the Department and /or to the Principal through their class representatives.
- The Institute premises and buildings should be kept tidy. Writing or sticking of posters and notices on the building walls is strictly prohibited.
