Rules & Regulations	JOINT DECLARATION BY THE STUDENT AND PARENT	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The students are expected to be regular in their class work with minimum of 75% of attendance and should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner. They should abide by such rules of discipline and conduct as stipulated by the institute from time to time. Students shall be condoned of shortage of attendance in aggregate up to 10% (65% and above and below 75%) in each semester may be granted by the college academic committee. It is permitted twice in eight semesters of IV year B.Pharm program. Shortage of attendance below 65% in aggregate, such case shall not be condoned. Students whose shortage of attendance is not condoned in any semester are not eligible to take their semester examination of the class and their registration shall be cancelled. The students should inform any changes such as the change address in the address of their parents / guardians in the College Office and examinations Control Office of the institute. Students of Krishna Teja Pharmacy College are not permitted to resort to strikes or demonstrations with in the college premise. Indulging in any such activity shall be viewed seriously and may result in dismissal from the college. If they come across any problem, they can bring it to the notice of concerned Head of the Department and /or to the Principal through their class representatives. The Institute premises and buildings should be kept tidy. Writing or sticking of posters and notices on the building walls is strictly prohibited. 		

7. I will not carry and use Cell phones in college premises and college buses.
8. Parents are requested to send their wards to the college by college busses only for safe journey. Two wheelers are strictly prohibited in the college premises.
9. The Institute is empowered to suspend, fine, rusticate or initiate any action against errant students.
10. If any student discontinues his / her studies for any reason he / she shall have to pay full amount of tuition fee for entire course.
11. I am aware that the curriculum for the various courses is rigid and my son / daughter / ward will follow the syllabi for the various courses in force at the time of his / her admission and that any revision or modification made in the syllabi during the course of his / her study in the Institution will be binding on him / her.
12. In case of my son's / daughter's / ward's progress in studies is uniformly poor in the institution his/her studies are liable to be terminated by issue of Transfer Certificate.
13. My son / daughter / ward is aware that breach of discipline and rules or bad conduct in the Institution or extra curricular activities will also entail summary forfeiture of seat in the Institution, in addition to such other proceedings that may be taken against him / her.
14. My son / daughter / ward should not involve himself / herself in any activity prejudicial to the proper conduct of study or discipline or peace in the College Campus such as involving himself / herself in strikes, unlawful assemblies, consumption of intoxicating drinks and drugs, the late attendance or any other infringement of rules and regulations and refusing to accept the punishment ordered by the Principal / Management.

6. Debarring from representing the institution any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
7. Suspension, expulsion from the hostel
8. Rustication from the institute for periods varying from 1 to 2 academic years
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other Institution
10. Rigorous imprisonment up to three years (by Court of Law) etc.

11. The stringent act of legislation and punishment for indulging in ragging are as follow:

S No	Extent of Offence	Penalty
1	Teasing or embarrassing or humiliating a student	Imprisonment upto 6 months or a fine upto Rs. 1,000/- both
2	Assault or use of criminal force or criminal intimidation	Imprisonment upto 1 year or a fine upto Rs. 2,000/- or both
3	Wrongful restraint or wrongful confinement or causing hurt	Imprisonment upto 2 years or a fine upto Rs. 5,000/- or both
4	Causing grievous hurt of kidnaping or abducting or committing rape or committing unnatural offence	Imprisonment upto 5 years or a fine upto Rs. 25,000/- or both
5	Causing death or abetting suicide	Imprisonment for life or for a term upto 10 years with fine upto Rs. 25,000/- or both
